## Climate Action Rally on Saturday

The Idaho Climate Action Community, along with more than 10 community organizations, will hold the <u>Second Annual Idaho Climate Action Rally</u> next Saturday, October 1 at the Capitol. Last year more than 300 people came out for climate solutions. This is the single largest day for climate advocacy in Idaho, and we need your support!

We will rally at the Idaho State Capitol Building in Boise at 11a.m. to hear a diverse group of speakers from Boise State University, the Idaho House of Representatives, Idaho Sierra Club, and other community leaders. A local musician will provide music during the event and booths will be set up in Capitol Park after the rally to answer questions about how your can get involved.
